In accordance with Section VII of the Department's Environmental Review Procedures for projects funded through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program, the Mountain Green Condominiums water system located in the Town of Killington, VT has requested its proposed water improvement project be evaluated for eligibility for a categorical exclusion exempting the project from detailed environmental procedures required for projects having a significant environmental impact.

The proposed project includes construction of a new 24' x 36' water treatment building to contain filtration and softening equipment, an aeration unit, and chlorine disinfection. The project will connect the two existing wells to the new treatment building and subsequently to the existing water storage tank.

Our consideration of the Mountain Green Condominiums request included review of an Environmental Information Document and supporting documentation prepared by Weston & Sampson Engineers dated July 28, 2011, and a site visit conducted by DWSRF staff on August 24, 2011. At the completion of this independent evaluation, the Department has determined the project meets the criteria for receiving a categorical exclusion.
