

***Updated Water Supply Fees
Effective July 1, 2004***

The Vermont State Legislature amended the fees for the below noted permits and certificates in accordance with Act Number 163 relating to Executive Branch Fees (House Bill H.0772). These current amendments will stand as noted until 2007.

Public Water System Construction

- Construction Permits: \$275 per application plus \$0.0055 per gallon of design capacity; \$110 for amendments
- Treatment Plant applications: \$0.003 per gallon of design capacity; \$110 for amendments

Public Water System Source Permit

- \$615 per source; \$110 for amendments

Public Water System Operating Permits

- Transient Non-community: \$0.0294 per 1,000 gallons of water produced or \$45 whichever is greater
- Non-Transient: \$0.0294 per 1,000 gallons of water produced annually or \$70, whichever is greater
- Community: \$0.0295 per 1,000 gallons of water produced annually for fiscal year 2004 (This will increase to \$0.0325 in 2005 and \$0.0359 for 2006)
- Bottled Water: \$550.00 per permitted facility; \$110 for amendments

Public Water System Operator Certificates

- Class 1: \$40.00 per initial certificate or renewal
- All other classes: \$70.00 per initial certificate or renewal

Well Driller License

- Water Well Driller and/or Monitor Well Driller: \$105 per initial application or renewal
- \$105 fee shall be paid on an annual basis for the duration of the license
