

**NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE VERMONT STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN**

Notice is hereby given that the Air Pollution Control Division has cancelled the public hearing on the proposed revisions to the Vermont State Implementation Plan (SIP).

The public hearing has been cancelled because the Division did not receive any requests for a hearing. The deadline to submit a request for a hearing was 5:00 p.m. on February 17, 2009.

The Air Pollution Control Division is proposing revisions to the Vermont SIP to address federal requirements with respect to (1) regional haze; and (2) the interstate transport of pollutants. The regional haze SIP revisions are being proposed to address the requirements under the federal Regional Haze Rule, 40 CFR 51.309. The transport SIP revisions are being proposed to address the requirements of Clean Air Act Section 110(a)(2)(D)(i) with respect to the interstate transport of ozone and fine particulate matter (PM<sub>2.5</sub>).
