

VERMONT OUTDOOR WOOD-FIRED BOILER (OWB) CHANGE-OUT PROGRAM VOUCHER APPLICATION FORM

HOW THE CHANGE-OUT PROGRAM WORKS

1. The Vermont Air Pollution Control Division (VT APCD) is offering rebate vouchers ranging from \$1,000-\$6,000* for the replacement of uncertified outdoor wood-fired boilers (OWB) with new VT-certified Phase II OWBs that use cordwood or wood pellets, or other APCD-approved heating appliances such as gas furnaces or boilers, indoor biomass boilers, or geothermal heating systems.
2. The VT APCD will review applications to determine if the preliminary qualification requirements have been met. Qualified applicants will receive a rebate voucher with a list of participating retailers. Rebate recipients must purchase their new heating appliance from a participating retailer by the expiration date on the voucher. Vouchers will be valid at participating retailers for an instant rebate off the price of the appliance.
3. Replacement heating systems installed indoors must be professionally installed.
4. Once you receive your new heating system, your current OWB **must be recycled or disposed of** in accordance with applicable law. Participating retailers will coordinate the destruction of old OWBs.
5. The retailer will take a photo of your existing OWB prior to removing it and will also take a photo of the new heating system when it is installed.
6. To apply for a voucher, please complete all sections of this application and retain a copy for your records. Prior to signing and submitting the completed application, carefully review the program terms and conditions. A photo of your current OWB must be submitted with this application. The OWB change-out program is not responsible for materials lost by mail.

Please note: Only owners of operational OWBs that are installed in Vermont and do not appear on the list of “Vermont-Certified OWB Models” are eligible to apply for change-out incentives.

Oct 1, 2011 – TBD*	All uncertified OWBs	Up to \$1,000 to match manufacturer rebates

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Only operational OWBs that are installed in Vermont and not certified to meet the Vermont Phase I or Phase II emissions standards are eligible to be replaced under this program.
2. The APCD will process complete applications in the order received. Vouchers will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis to qualified applicants during the applicable time frames. Funding is limited and vouchers are not guaranteed.
3. Current OWBs must be rendered permanently inoperable when replacement heating systems are delivered and then recycled or disposed of at an approved facility.
4. Participants must enter into an agreement of sale for a replacement system with a participating retailer by the expiration date on the voucher and have the new system installed by the installation date on the voucher.
5. Indoor replacement heating systems must be professionally installed by a certified installer.
6. Participants are responsible for any costs above the voucher amount.
7. Participants must forfeit vouchers if false information is provided.
8. Participants agree to provide VT APCD staff access to their property to inspect current OWBs and/or replacement systems; the VT APCD will provide at least two days advance notice.
9. The VT APCD provides no warranties for devices purchased under this rebate program.
10. No rebates will be provided for OWBs replaced prior to the issuance of an approved voucher.
