Municipal Pollution Control Projects Priority List for State FY 2008 Amendment**Municipalities and Interested Parties:**

On August 22, 2007, pursuant to the authority provided in the State of Vermont Municipal Pollution Control Priority System, the Department of Environmental Conservation adopted The *FY 2008 Pollution Control Projects Priority List*. In accord with Sections 410 and 420 of the Municipal Pollution Control Priority System the Department has reviewed the status of projects on that List and the requests of municipalities for funding of projects not included on the Construction Projects portion of the List. On February 15, 2008 the Department proposed to amend the List as specified below and requested that all comments be submitted by March 3. No comments were received.

The Department of Environmental Conservation amends the FY 2008 Pollution Control Construction Projects Priority List by adding the following projects in the specified category:


Refurbishment:

Shelburne; Longmeadow Pump Station; Estimated Project Cost and SRF Loan: \$200,000; 3.88 Points
Johnson; Route 15 Sewer Siphon; Estimated Project Cost and SRF Loan: \$200,000; 4.64 Points
