

**Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation
Joint Public Hearing of the
Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) &
Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF)**

The Vermont Water Supply Division and Facilities Engineering Division will hold a public hearing on **Friday, March 20, 2009, 1:00 to 4:00 P.M., Summit Training Center located in the Osgood Building in the Waterbury State Office Complex.** The purpose of the hearing is to discuss the Intended Use Plan (IUP)/Project Priority Lists and solicit public input regarding the administration of the federal economic stimulus funds in the Vermont Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Programs. The federal legislation is now in final form and approximately 20 million dollars in additional funding will be available to each of the respective programs.
