**WASTEWATER SYSTEM AND POTABLE WATER SUPPLY FOR
 EXTENSION OF SEWER LINES**

SUMMARY - PERMIT DESCRIPTION	Purpose is to ensure that sewer lines are constructed to proper standards.
REGULATED ACTIVITY EXAMPLE	Any project that requires the extension of a municipal sewer line.
INFORMATION REQUIRED	Description of project including length of extension, number of units to be connected, projected flows, design of sewer extension.

FEES	Usually none because construction is normally in conjunction with and a part of a wastewater system and potable water supply permit application for a subdivision of land, public building, mobile home park, or campground. Municipal projects are usually exempt from fees.

AUTHORITY	10 VSA Section 1271
APPEALS	Effective January 31, 2005, within 30 days of the date of an act or decision, any person aggrieved by an act or decision of the secretary, or any party by right, may appeal to the environmental court in accordance with the provisions of 10 VSA Chapter 220 .
APPLICABLE RULES	Environmental Protection Rules, Chapter 1, Wastewater System and Potable Water Supply Rules , effective September 29, 2007.
OTHER PERMITS	Municipal and Act 250 permits and approvals may apply.

ACT 250 INTERFACE

Under the [Vermont Environmental Board](#), Rules of Procedure, Rule 19(E), the sewer line extension permit, when entered in the record, may create the presumption that waste materials and wastewater can be disposed of through installation of wastewater and waste collection, treatment and disposal systems without resulting in undue water pollution.
