PERMIT AND LICENSE INFORMATION

DISCHARGE PERMIT: MUNICIPAL

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT Regulates discharges to surface waters from municipal wastewater treatment facilities.

EXAMPLE OF REGULATED ACTIVITY Sanitary sewage.

CRITERIA FOR JURISDICTION This permit is for direct discharges of treated sewage to surface waters.

INFORMATION REQUIRED Description of the volume of wastewater discharged, type of technology, plans and specifications of treatment system proposed by the applicant, location of discharge.

FEES

New or Amended Permit: \$0.0023 per gallon of design capacity application review fee, minimum \$50.00 per outfall, maximum \$30,000 per application, plus \$100.00 administrative processing fee per application.

Renewal Permit: \$100.00 administrative processing fee per application.

Operating Permits: \$.0027 per gallon of actual flows with \$100.00 minimum, \$11,000.00 maximum.

APPLICATION TIME FRAME

The performance standard for processing a complete application:
 New individual permit 150 days; with hearing 195 days
 Renewal permit 120 days; with hearing 165 days
