PERMIT AND LICENSE INFORMATION

ELECTRICAL PERMIT - INSTALLATION

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT An electrical permit is required for all electrical installations in public buildings to ensure that qualified persons properly install the electrical wiring.

INFORMATION REQUIRED The master electrician, type S journeyman, or in the case of a duplex, the owner or general contractor submits a work notice to the regional office indicating the scope of the electrical work to be done. Inspections are scheduled at different stages during the work.

FEES The schedule of fees is contained in the Vermont Electrical Safety Rules and is based on the size and number of the electrical components covered by the permit.

APPLICATION TIME FRAME Within 5 days of the request for an inspection, an inspection will be conducted, scheduled or waived.
