

FLOOD DEBRIS

SEPARATE THESE ITEMS FROM OTHER TRASH

Most flood debris can be disposed in one container. EXCEPT:

- **Dangerous wastes – *toxics, pesticides, explosives, gasoline, pool chemicals, acids, drain cleaner, fireworks, flares, ammo, unprotected “sharps”***
- **Car Batteries & Rechargeable Batteries**
- **Electronics**
- **Hazardous Waste**
- **Mercury products – *fluor. bulbs, thermostats, thermometers***
- **Oil, Brake Cleaner, other toxic car products**
- **Oil Based Paint, Stain, Varnish, Paint Thinner/Stripper**
- **Propane cylinders, other gas cylinders**
- **Tires**
- **Large appliances *refrigerators, freezers, stoves, washers, dryers* & Scrap Metal**
