The Environmental Assistance Office is comprised primarily of non-regulatory assistance programs. The Office provides guidance to permit applicants and offers environmental compliance assistance to Vermont businesses and municipalities. Staff provides assistance and outreach to businesses, communities, state agencies, and others to identify effective and economical ways to reduce waste at the source in order to avoid waste treatment and disposal costs and to safeguard human health and the environment. The Office also provides internal Department-wide coordination and improvement services related to permitting, compliance, enforcement, and information system. The Office oversees implementation of mercury product requirements on manufacturers and users of mercury products and operates a Mercury Education and Reduction Program.
